Responsibilities

- Place the health, safety, and wellness of our member participants above all else
- Execute a weekly menu including breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snack
- Train volunteer kitchen crew on proper food safety protocols and standards
- Maintain cleanliness and sanitation of the kitchen area pursuant to Department of Health standards
- Perform mandatory daily and pre/post trip inspection of assigned vehicle
- Notify Operations Manager and Corps Director of any equipment failure, safety concerns, and/or operational issues
- Manage the inventory of food and serving items
- Perform necessary shopping during Spring Training and while on tour
- Adapt to individual needs relating to food allergies, vegetarian, or vegan meals
- Other responsibilities as assigned

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent work experience
- 2+ years in the food service industry
- Catering/industrial kitchen experience a plus
- Comfortable in a fast-paced, change-oriented environment, skilled in dealing with young adults
- Must have personality and character traits suited to working with and care of members of varied ethnicities, cultural values, behavioral tendencies, and physical handicaps
- Able to communicate effectively and professionally with members, volunteers, and staff
