Your efforts will directly contribute to providing an exciting and safe experience to our members, staff, administration, and volunteers.

### **Responsibilities**

- Place the health, safety, and wellness of our member participants above all else
- Provide basic health care to members in case of injury or acute illness
- Develop health plans for members with chronic illnesses and disabilities
- Educate members and staff on healthy habits, such as proper nutrition and hygiene
- Detect health problems in early stages
- Keep track of member health records and update members' medical history
- Ensure environment is safe for members and staff (e.g. prevention of communicable diseases)
- Ensure compliance with national and local health laws
- Adapt to individual needs relating to food allergies, vegetarian, or vegan meals
- Manage care of members requiring assistance beyond first aid with local hospitals and urgent care facilities
- Other responsibilities as assigned

### **Requirements**

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent work experience
- Certification as a Registered Nurse, LPN, or other professional medical certification
- 2+ years in the health care profession
- School experience a plus
- Comfortable in a fast-paced, change-oriented environment, skilled in dealing with young adults
- Must have personality and character traits suited to working with and care of members of varied ethnicities, cultural values, behavioral tendencies, and physical handicaps
- Able to communicate effectively and professionally with members, volunteers, and staff
